THUR FEB 01 - DEPARTURE CANADA

Day 1: FRI FEB 02 - ARRIVAL ARUSHA (Kilimanjaro Airport)

Day 2: SAT FEB 03 - FREE DAY & Nairobi Kenya Tour Arrivals (Avg. High 28C, Low 15C)

FREE DAY. For those continuing the tour from Kenya, we will fly early morning from Nairobi to Kilimanjaro Airport. We will meet up at the hotel with those that have chosen a Tanzania only tour. Your afternoon is free and tonight we will enjoy a *Welcome Reception*.

DAY 3: SUN FEB 04 - LAKE MANYARA NATIONAL PARK (Avg. High 28C, Low 15C)

Today we drive to Lake Manyara. Lake Manyara is situated in the Rift Valley region and is well known for tree-climbing lions, the soda ask lake that attracts thousands of pink flamingos, one of Tanzania's biggest elephant population and breathtaking scenery!

We will check in to our hotel, enjoy a picnic lunch followed by a game drive inside the Park.

DAY 4: MON FEB 05 – TO NDUTU – SERENGETI SOUTH (Avg. High 28C, Low 15C)

Today we head west on our safari adventure in the Ndutu area of the Ngorongoro Conservation Reserve. Here we will witness one of nature's greatest miracles: Life. This area forms part of the annual migratory route of hundreds of thousands of wildebeest, zebra, antelopes and their predators and Dec to March is the annual calving season. It is famous for offering consistently the best wildlife viewing experience during the green season.

Following breakfast, we will drive to Ndutu via the Ngorongoro Crater and continue to the southern Serengeti area of Ndutu, enjoying a game drive enroute to our tented camp.

Leaving Serengeti National Park early in the morning, we will drive to Ngoro Ngoro Crater for an unforgettable wildlife and panoramic experience. Later in the evening we will check-in to the Ngorongoro Serena Safari Lodge, overlooking the crater rim.

Tarangire National Park is famous for its large herds of elephants and big baobab trees. The drive to Tarangire is relatively short, so we may make some stops along the way.

Late afternoon arrival in time to watch the sun set over beautiful Lake Burunge.
